Logansport, Indiana – Aviation enthusiasts have joined together to start a local Chapter of the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA), the leader in Recreational Aviation. Logansport Chapter 1417 received provisional status on April 4, 2008 and is planned to receive its full charter with the next 45 days.

EAA has more than 1,000 Chapters around the world, which provide activities for aviation enthusiasts in the communities and regions. Chapter activities range from monthly meetings, to airport open houses, fly-ins, and pancake breakfasts that share aviation with the community and build a stronger bond between local aviation and the general public. Other EAA Chapter efforts include Young Eagles activities, which share the world of flight with a new generation and aircraft building projects. Most EAA Chapter members are pilots, but non-flying enthusiasts are also an important part of an EAA Chapter.

Airport Manager Tim Dalton, who also serves as Chapter 1417 President said that establishing a chapter in Logansport was an important step to strengthen aviation activity in the Logansport and Cass County area, but to also reach out and provide opportunities to future aviation enthusiasts.
