Modernization Plans Move Forward

Construction has started on the new Operations Center at the Logansport/Cass County Airport. The new facility features improved pilot and passenger amenities, as well as management and operations offices. "A modern aviation facility, designed and operated to maximize service for all users, is a fundamental component of local infrastructure necessary to be considered by corporations that provide jobs to invest in our community" According to Air-



port Authority President Mark Hildebrandt. "Multinational corporations own and operate jet aircraft that require not only a runway long enough to operate jet aircraft safely, but an operations center that provides a full spectrum of services in a professional atmosphere". Hildebrandt further stated "When the new operations center is completed at the end of 2008, Logansport and Cass County will have one of the most up to date, functional aviation facilities in northern Indiana" The main attraction to the building is the attached 80'X85' hangar that will accommodate most corporate jets or several small aircraft. As construction moves forward the Airport Authority will market the new facility with plans to attract a full service FBO when the building is completed .

Within a 50 mile radius of GGP, the average price per gallon for 100LL is \$4.81 according to airnav.com. As of June 5th our price of \$4.24 is the lowest. During July, August and September we will

Runway Extension Receives FAA Approval

On May 15th the Logansport/Cass County Airport Authority received environmental approval from the FAA for the planned runway extension project. Having environmental approval allows for the project to be eligible for federal funding. The Airport Authority now shifts the focus from getting the project approved to getting the project funded. Since the 2008 funding deadline has already passed, the focus will be on obtaining 2009 funds.

Both 100LL and Jet-A are now available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Airport staff will continue to provide full service fueling during normal business hours.
